<i>un habit</i>	a piece of clothing
<i>un habitude</i>	a habit
<i>un hébergement</i>	a lodging
<i>un hectare</i>	a hectare
<i>un héritage</i>	a legacy
<i>un hélicopter</i>	a helicopter
<i>un hêtre</i>	a beech
<i>une histoire</i>	a story
<i>une hirondelle</i>	a swallow
<i>un homme</i>	a man
<i>un hôte</i>	a host
<i>une hôtesse de l'air</i>	an air hostess
<i>l'herbe</i>	the grass
<i>une heure</i>	an hour
<i>l'horloge</i>	the clock
<i>l'horizon</i>	the horizon
<i>l'humeur</i>	the mood
<i>hésiter: j'hésite</i>	to hesitate



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20 useful words with an aspirated h, no liaison or elision possible		
<i>un / hibou</i>	an owl	
<i>un / hamster</i>	a hamster	
<i>un / hérisson</i>	a hedgehog	
<i>un / homard</i>	a lobster	
<i>un / huitième</i>	en eighth	
<i>le / handball</i>	handball	
<i>la / hanche</i>	the hip	
<i>un / haricot</i>	a green bean	(although it has changed and nowadays it is possible to say both <i>un haricot</i> and <i>un / haricot</i>)
<i>un / handicap</i>	a disability	
<i>la / honte</i>	the shame	
<i>le / hoquet</i>	the hiccup	
<i>le / hublot</i>	the porthole	
<i>la Hollande</i>	Holland	
<i>la Hongrie</i>	Hungary	
<i>hurler: je / hurle, ...</i>	to yell	
<i>haïr: je / hais, ...</i>	to hate	
<i>hanter: je / hante, ...</i>	to haunt	
<i>harceler: je / harcèle...</i>	to harass
