## Expressions of time used with the present to denote the future

| Expression  | English   |
|---|---|
| <b>el lunes, el martes, el miércoles, el jueves, el viernes, el sábado, el domingo</b> (days of the week) | on Monday, on Tuesday, on Wednesday, on Thursday, on Friday, on Saturday, on Sunday |
| <b>El (lunes, martes, miércoles...) que viene...</b>  | next (day of the week)  |
| <b>El día (date)</b>  | on the day...   |
| <b>El día siguiente...</b>  | the following day   |
| <b>La próxima semana.../ La semana que viene...</b>   | next week...  |
| <b>El próximo día/ mes...</b>   | next day/month...   |
| <b>Esta tarde/noche</b>   | this evening/night  |
| <b>Mañana</b>   | tomorrow  |
| <b>Mañana por la (mañana/tarde/noche)...</b>  | tomorrow morning/afternoon/night  |

| Example  | Translation                             |
|--|---|
| <b>Nos vemos el martes.</b>                          | See you (on) Tuesday!                   |
| <b>El jueves que viene vamos a comprar un carro.</b> | Next Thursday we're going to buy a car. |
| <b>El examen es el día 2 de agosto.</b>              | The exam is on the second of August.    |
| <b>Nos vemos el día siguiente en el partido.</b>     | See you the following day at the game.  |
| <b>La próxima semana salgo de viaje.</b>             | Next week I'm traveling.                |
| <b>Nos vamos de viaje el próximo mes.</b>            | We are going on a trip next month.      |
| <b>El avión aterriza esta noche.</b>                 | The plane lands tonight.                |
| <b>El proyecto es para mañana.</b>                   | The project is for (is due) tomorrow.   |
| <b>He quedado con Lucía mañana por la mañana.</b>    | I am seeing Lucía tomorrow morning.     |

## Expressions of time used with the present to denote the future.

| Spanish  | English                    |
|--|----------------------------|
| <b>Pasado mañana</b>                           | the day after tomorrow     |
| <b>En agosto, en septiembre...</b><br>(months) | in August, in September... |
| <b>El mes/año que viene...</b>                 | next month/year            |
| <b>El mes/año entrante...</b>                  | the upcoming month         |


| Spanish  | English   |
|--|---|
| <b>La actuación de magia es pasado mañana.</b>   | The magic show is the day after tomorrow.         |
| <b>Ariane viene en agosto.</b>                   | Ariane is coming next August.                     |
| <b>El año que viene vamos a viajar mucho.</b>    | Next year we are going to travel a lot.           |
| <b>El mes entrante tengo cita con el doctor.</b> | I have a doctor's appointment the upcoming month. |

## Expressions used with the present that denote the future.

| Spanish                         | English  |
|---------------------------------|--|
| <b>Hay que + infinitive</b>     | it's necessary (proposition)                           |
| <b>Pensar (en) + infinitive</b> | to think on (intention to do something/ to make plans) |
| <b>Tener que + infinitive</b>   | to have to (for obligation)                            |
| <b>Es para + (day/time)</b>     | to be for/ to be due (deadline)                        |

| Spanish                                    | English                           |
|--|-----------------------------------|
| <b>Hay que prepara la maleta.</b>          | We need to pack the suitcase.     |
| <b>Pienso limpiar en la mañana</b>         | I plan to clean in the morning.   |
| <b>Tengo que hacer el examen muy bien.</b> | I have to nail the exam.          |
| <b>La tarea es para el miércoles.</b>      | The homework is due on Wednesday. |
