



SPANISH TABLE

Adjectives that change meaning with *ser* or *estar*



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The adjectives below change meaning depending of whether they are preceded by *ser* or *estar*.

Adjectives with <i>ser</i>	Meaning	Example
<i>ser malo/mala</i>	badly behaved or to have bad quality	<i>Esta marca de ropa es muy mala.</i> This clothing brand has bad quality.
<i>ser aburrido/aburrida</i>	boring	<i>El amigo de mi hermana no habla de nada, es muy aburrido.</i> My sister's friend doesn't speak about anything, he's very boring.
<i>ser bueno/buena</i>	well behaved or to have good quality	<i>Mi perrito Tommy es muy bueno.</i> My dog Tommy is very well behaved.
<i>ser listo/lista</i>	clever, smart	<i>Los estudiantes entienden muy rápido. Son muy listos.</i> The students understand very quickly. They're very smart.
<i>ser moreno/morena</i>	dark haired	<i>Ana es rubia y su hermano es moreno.</i> Ana is blond and her brother is dark haired.



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Adjectives with <i>ser</i>	Meaning	Example
<i>ser rico/rica</i>	wealthy	<i>Esa familia es muy rica. Tienen mucho dinero.</i> That family is very wealthy. They have a lot of money.
<i>ser despierto/despierta</i>	smart	<i>Mi sobrino tiene un año y es tan despierto.</i> My nephew is one year old and he's so smart.
<i>ser orgulloso/orgullosa</i>	vain, arrogant	<i>Es demasiado orgulloso de su apariencia física.</i> He's too arrogant about his physical appearance.
<i>ser verde</i>	green	<i>Esa mesa es verde.</i> That table is green.
<i>ser interesado/interesada</i>	selfish, opportunist	<i>Fernando es muy interesado. Solo te ayuda si obtiene algo a cambio.</i> Fernando is very selfish. He only helps you if he gets something in return.



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<i>ser vivo/viva</i>	sharp, astute	Tienes que ser vivo para hacer negocios. You have to be astute to do business.
<i>ser abierto/abierta</i>	extroverted	Mi mejor amiga es abierta y habla de cualquier tema. My best friend is extroverted and talks about any topic.
<i>ser atento/atenta</i>	attentive, thoughtful	Mi madre es muy atenta con sus invitados. My mother is very thoughtful with her guests.
<i>ser cerrado/cerrada</i>	introverted	Soy una persona cerrada. No expreso mis emociones fácilmente. I'm an introverted person. I don't express my emotions easily.
<i>ser consciente</i>	aware of something	¿Eres consciente del problema que tenemos? Are you aware of the problem we have?



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<i>ser delicado/delicada</i>	fragile	<i>Mi abuela me regaló esta porcelana. Es muy delicada.</i> My grandmother gave me this porcelain. It's very fragile.
<i>ser molesto/molesta</i>	annoying	<i>Los gatos de mi vecino son muy molestos.</i> My neighbor's cats are very annoying.
<i>ser seco/seca</i>	curt	<i>Mi padre es un hombre muy directo y es seco para decir las cosas.</i> My father is a very direct man and he has a curt way of saying things.
<i>ser claro/clara</i>	clear (for the sky), light (for colors)	<i>Esos zapatos son azul claro.</i> Those shoes are light blue.
<i>ser grave</i>	serious	<i>Este es un tema grave que necesitamos tratar de inmediato.</i> This is a serious topic we need to deal with immediately.



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<i>ser maduro/madura</i>	mature	<i>Sebastián es un niño muy maduro para su edad.</i> Sebastian is a very mature boy for his age.
<i>ser seguro/segura</i>	confident	<i>Los candidatos son muy seguros de sí mismos.</i> The candidates are very confident.



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Adjectives with estar	Meaning	Example
estar malo/mala	sick	El niño no puede ir a la escuela hoy, está malo. The boy can't go to school today, he's sick.
estar aburrido/aburrida	bored	¡No tengo nada qué hacer, estoy aburrida! I have nothing to do, I'm bored!
estar bueno/buena	tasty (for food), attractive	Esta comida está muy buena. This meal is tasty.
estar listo/lista	prepared, ready	¿Estás lista para nuestro viaje? Are you ready for our trip?
estar moreno/morena	tanned	Miguel fue a la playa y ahora está moreno. Miguel went to the beach and now he's tanned.
estar rico/rica	tasty (for food)	La torta de chocolate está rica. The chocolate cake is tasty.



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Adjectives with estar	Meaning	Example
estar despierto/despierta	awake	Juan durmió bien y ahora está despierto. Juan slept well and he's awake now.
estar orgulloso/orgullosa	proud, pleased	Estamos orgullosos de ti. Hiciste un excelente trabajo. We're proud of you. You did an excellent job.
estar verde	immature, unripe	Esa fruta todavía está verde, no la puedes comer así. That fruit is still unripe, you can't eat it like that.
estar interesado/interesada	interested	Estoy interesada en aprender español. I'm interested in learning Spanish.
estar vivo/viva	alive	Mi bisabuelo está vivo y tiene 110 años. My great grandfather is alive and he is 110 years old.



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estar abierto/abierta	open	El centro comercial está abierto de 10 a 8. The shopping center is open from 10 to 8.
estar atento/atenta	paying attention	Los niños están atentos a lo que dice la profesora. The children are paying attention to what the teacher says.
estar cerrado/cerrada	closed	La tienda de ropa está cerrada hoy. The clothes shop is closed today.
estar consciente	awake, conscious	El accidente fue terrible, pero ellos están conscientes. The accident was terrible, but they're conscious.
estar delicado/delicada	in poor health	Ella está en el hospital hace dos semanas y está muy delicada. She's been in the hospital for two weeks and she's in poor health.



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estar molesto/molesta	angry	Mis padres están molestos conmigo por mis calificaciones. My parents are angry at me because of my grades.
estar seco/seca	dry	Estas plantas están muy secas, necesitan agua. These plants are very dry, they need water.
estar claro/clara	obvious	Está claro que necesitamos estudiar más. It's obvious we need to study more.
estar grave	in poor health	El doctor dice que el paciente está grave y necesita cirugía. The doctor says the patient is in poor health and needs surgery.



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estar maduro/madura	ripe	Usa estos bananas para el postre, ya están maduros. Use these bananas for the dessert, they're ripe.
estar seguro/segura	sure	Andrea está segura de obtener el trabajo. Andrea is sure she'll get the job.
