## Monosyllabic and two syllable homonyms

Monosyllabic homonyms			
Word	Example	Word	Example
<b>el</b> (definite article) the	<b>El</b> coche es azul. The car is blue.	<b>él</b> (personal pronoun) he	Haz lo que <b>él</b> te diga. Do as he tells you.
<b>de</b> (preposition) of, from	Vengo <b>de</b> la casa <b>de</b> mi primo. I'm coming from my cousin's house.	<b>dé</b> (imperative of <i>dar</i> (to give) for <i>usted</i> [you formal]) you give	No me <b>dé</b> más problemas. Don't give me more problems.
<b>mas</b> (conjunction) but	Lo haré, <b>mas</b> no estoy de acuerdo. I'll do it, but I don't agree with it.	<b>más</b> (adverb) more	No quiero <b>más</b> , estoy <i>llena</i> . I don't want more, I'm full.
<b>mi</b> (possessive adjective) my	Estoy impaciente por mudarme a <b>mi</b> <i>nueva casa</i> . I can't wait to move to my new place.	<b>mí</b> (personal pronoun) me	¿Este paquete es para <b>mí</b> ? Is this package for me?
<b>se</b> (reflexive pronoun) himself, herself	<b>Se</b> va a duchar más tarde. She's going to shower later.	<b>sé</b> (present tense of <i>saber</i> (to know) for <i>yo</i> (I)) I know	No <b>sé</b> por qué se fue. I don't know why he left.
<b>tu</b> (possessive adjective) your	<b>Tu</b> ensayo es muy bueno. Your paper is very good.	<b>tú</b> (personal pronoun) you	María y <b>tú</b> deben irse ya. You and María must go now.
<b>te</b> (reflexive, direct/ indirect object pronoun) yourself/to you	No <b>te</b> oigo. I can't hear you.	<b>té</b> (noun) tea	¿Quieren café o <b>té</b> ? Would you like coffee or tea?
<b>si</b> (conditional conjunction) if	<b>Si</b> lo quieres, te lo regalo. If you want it, you can have it.	<b>sí</b> (adverb) yes	Tienes que contestar <b>sí</b> o no. You have to answer yes or no.
		<b>sí</b> (personal pronoun) to himself, to herself	En su libro, se critica a <b>sí</b> mismo. In his book, he criticizes himself.



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Two syllable homonyms			
Word	Example	Word	Example
<b>aun</b> (adverb) even	<i>Me gustan todos, aun los rojos.</i> I like them all, even the red ones.	<b>aún</b> (adverb) still/yet	<b>Aún</b> no he terminado. I haven't finished yet.
<b>porque</b> (conjunction) because	<i>No estudié porque estuve enfermo.</i> I didn't study because I was sick.	<b>porqué</b> (noun) reason	<i>Quieren saber el porqué de sus actos.</i> They want to know the reason for her actions.
